# Survey background

---

- 800 Latino voters across 9 battleground states and 57 House districts
  - States: AZ, CO, FL, GA, NC, NH, NV, PA, WI
  - N=297 in BG districts
- Final sample weighted to match demographic profile of Latino voters across battleground states + districts
- Bilingual, conducted by phone + online July 26-Aug 3, 2022
- Overall margin of error is +/- 3.5%

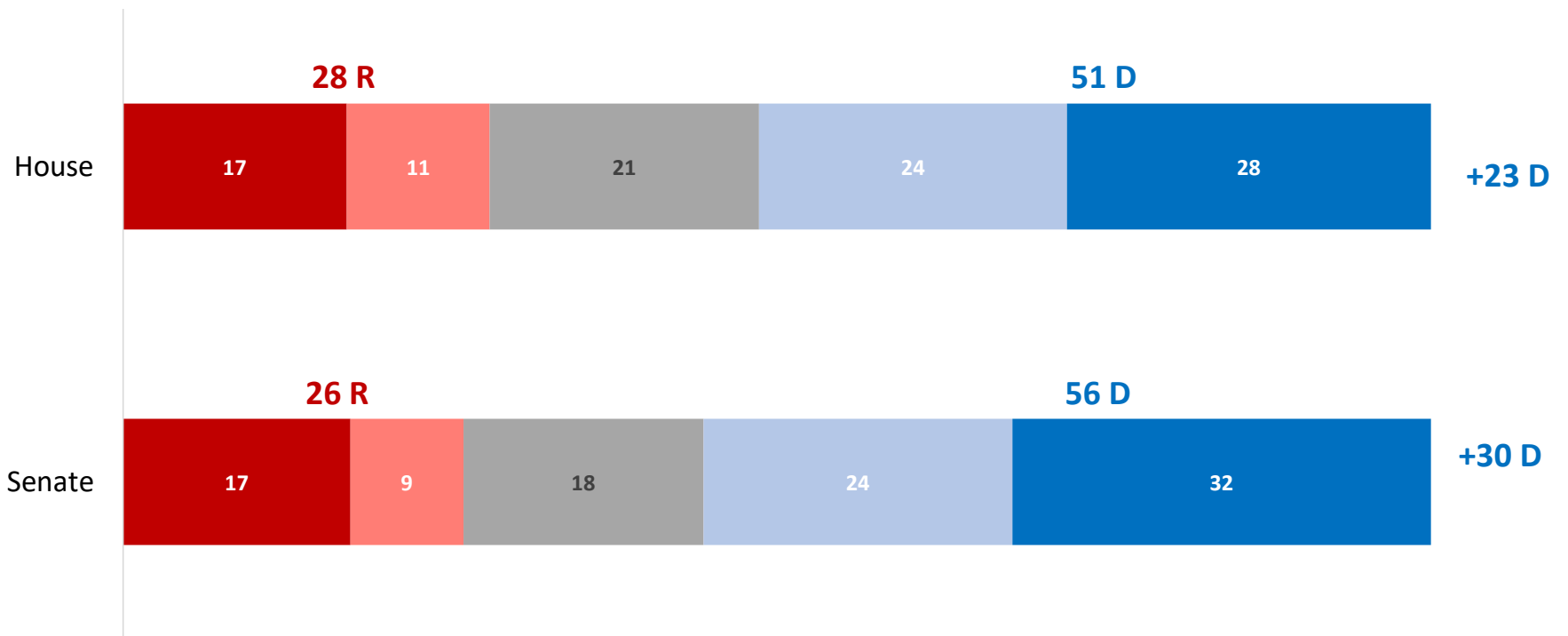
# General Latino voter profile

---

- 800 Latino voters across 9 battleground states and 57 House districts
  - Democrat 52%; Republican 23%; Independent 25%
  - First time voter in 2020 (29%); first time voter in 2018 (13%); voted in 2016 or earlier (58%)
  - Age 18 to 29 (31%); 30 to 49 (42%); 50 plus (27%)
  - US Born (71%); Puerto Rico (3%); Foreign born (26%)
  - Survey in Spanish (21%); Speak Spanish family/friends daily (51%)
  - Knows somebody undocumented (51%); someone in their family is undocumented (23%)
- Overall margin of error is +/- 3.5%

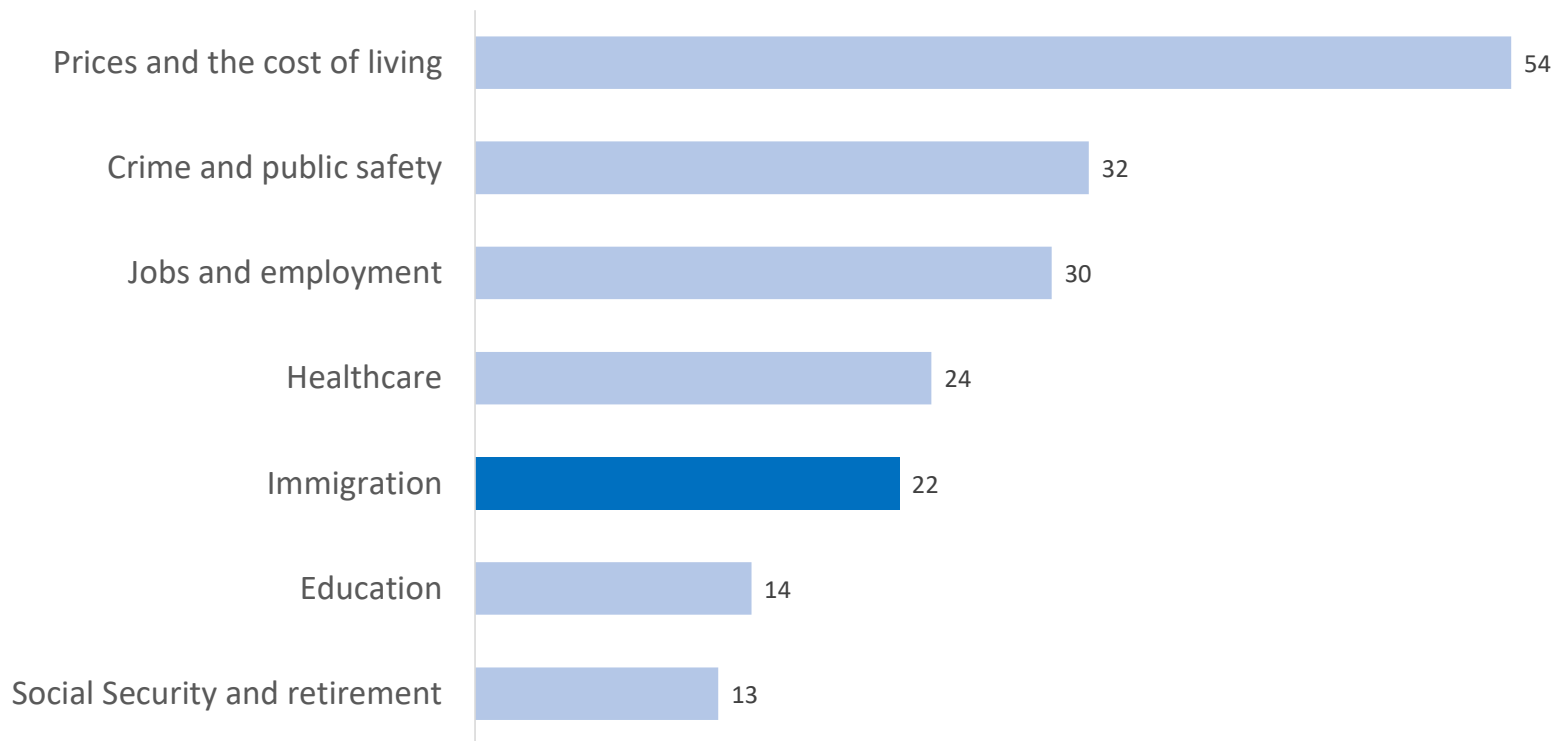
How Latinos plan to vote in 2022

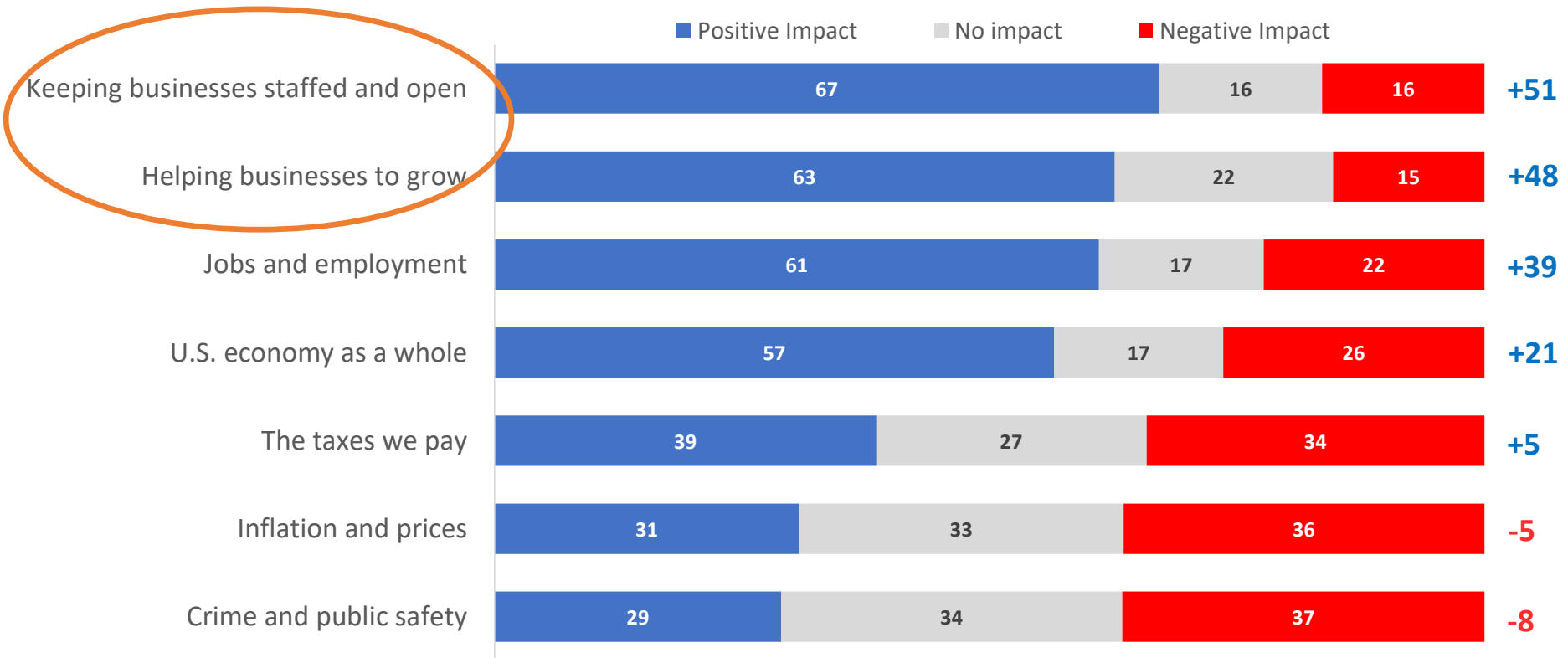

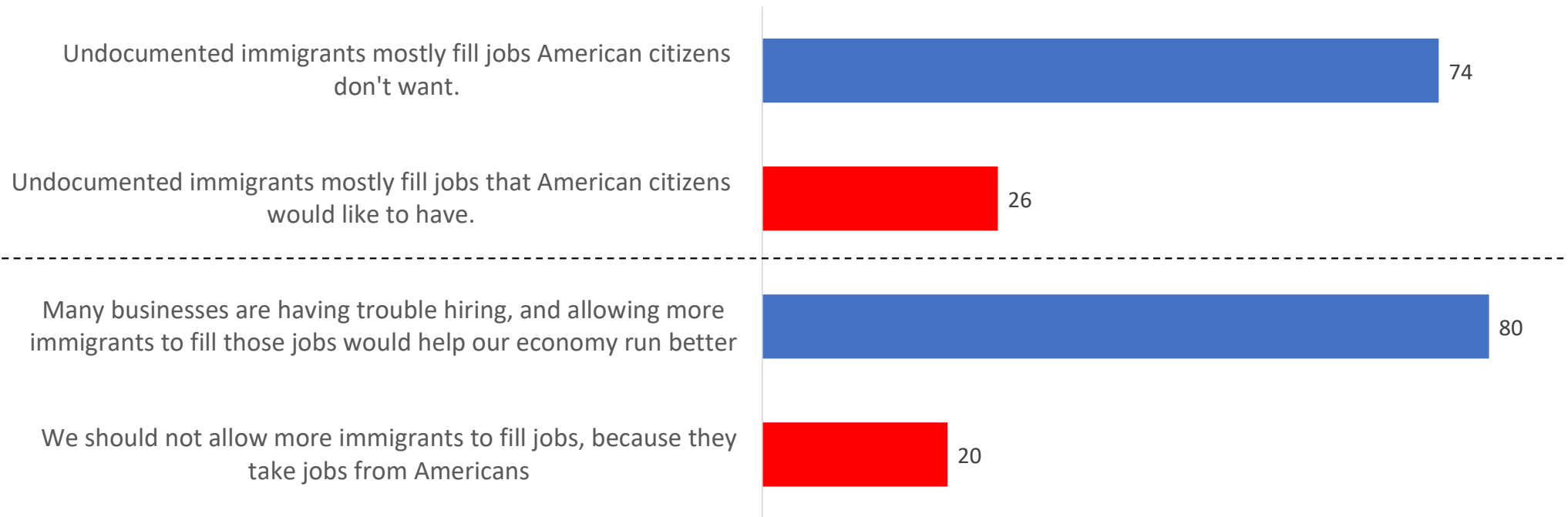

Latino voters: Impact Immigration has on \_\_\_\_\_



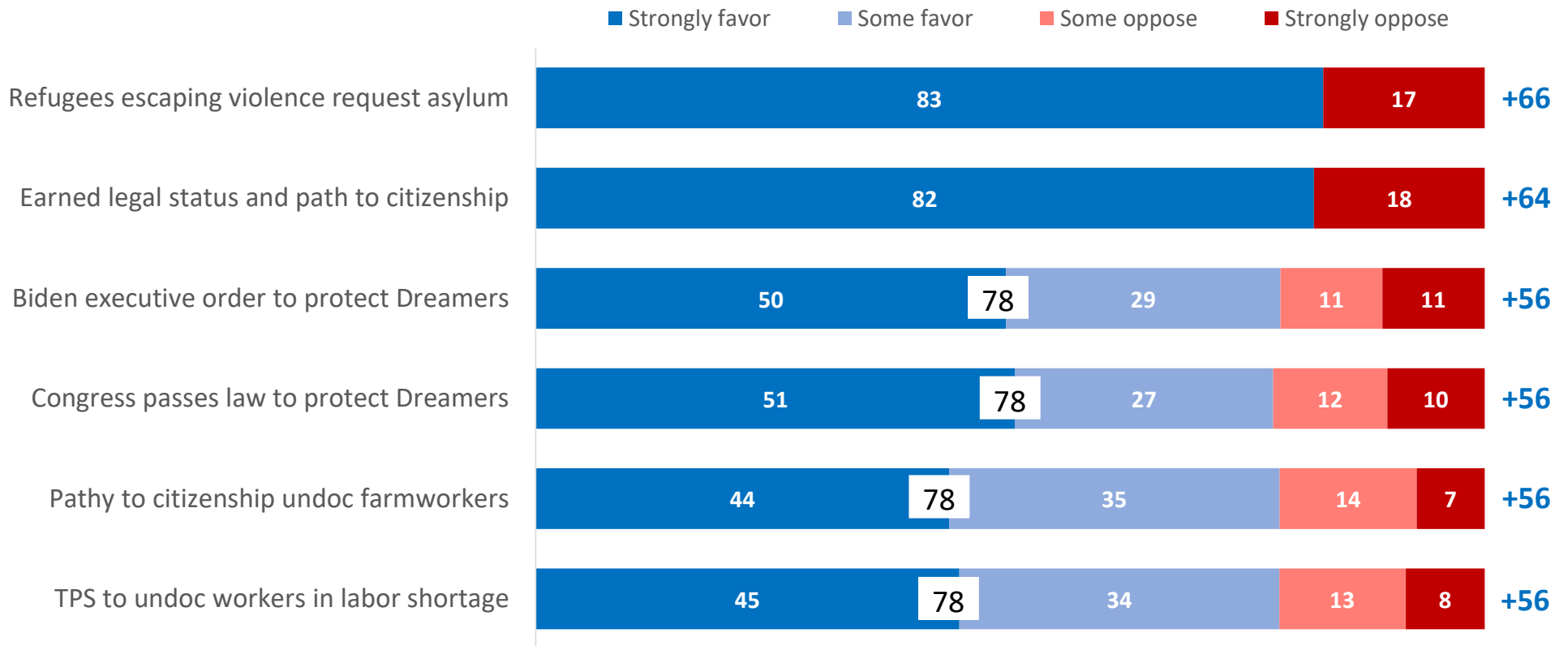
# Immigrants are NOT seen as taking jobs

Latino voters: Which comes closer to your view...



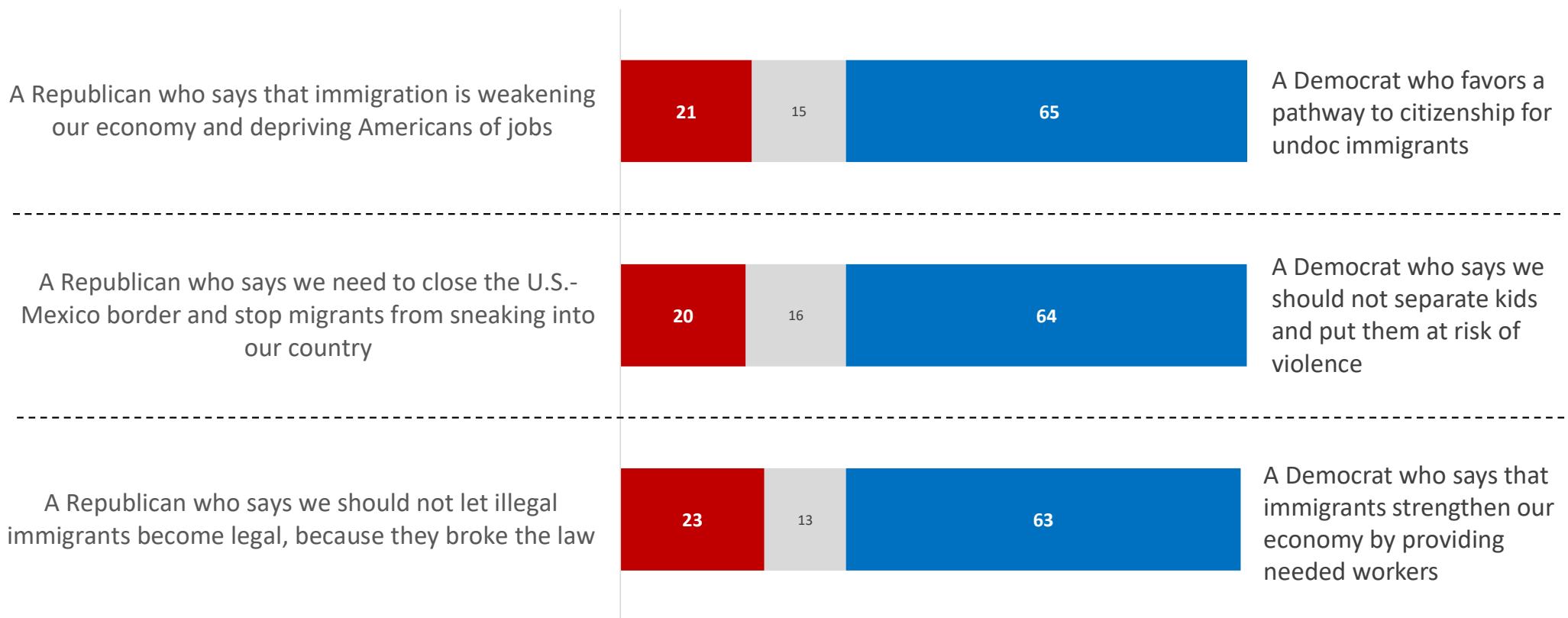
# Support for protecting undocumented immigrants

## Latino voters: support for various immigration policy

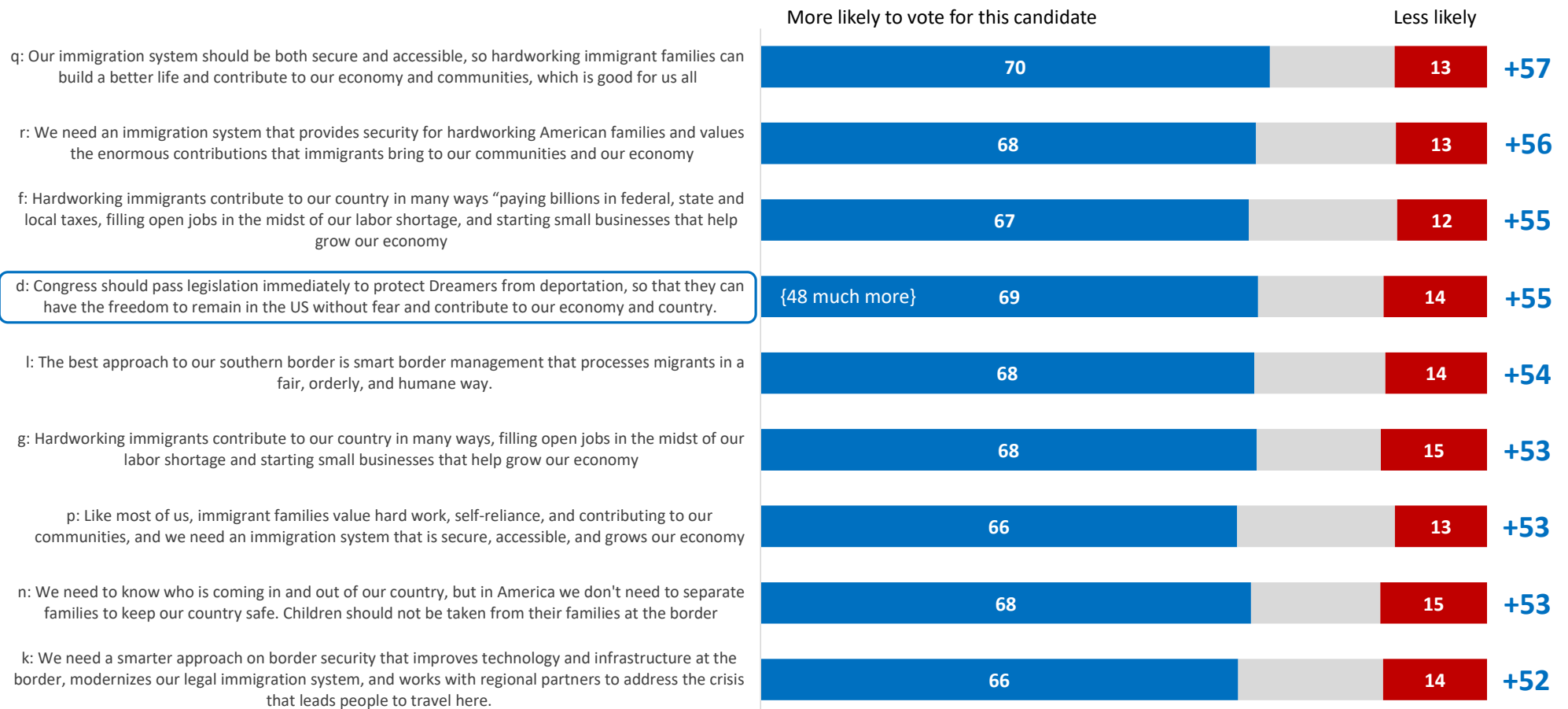

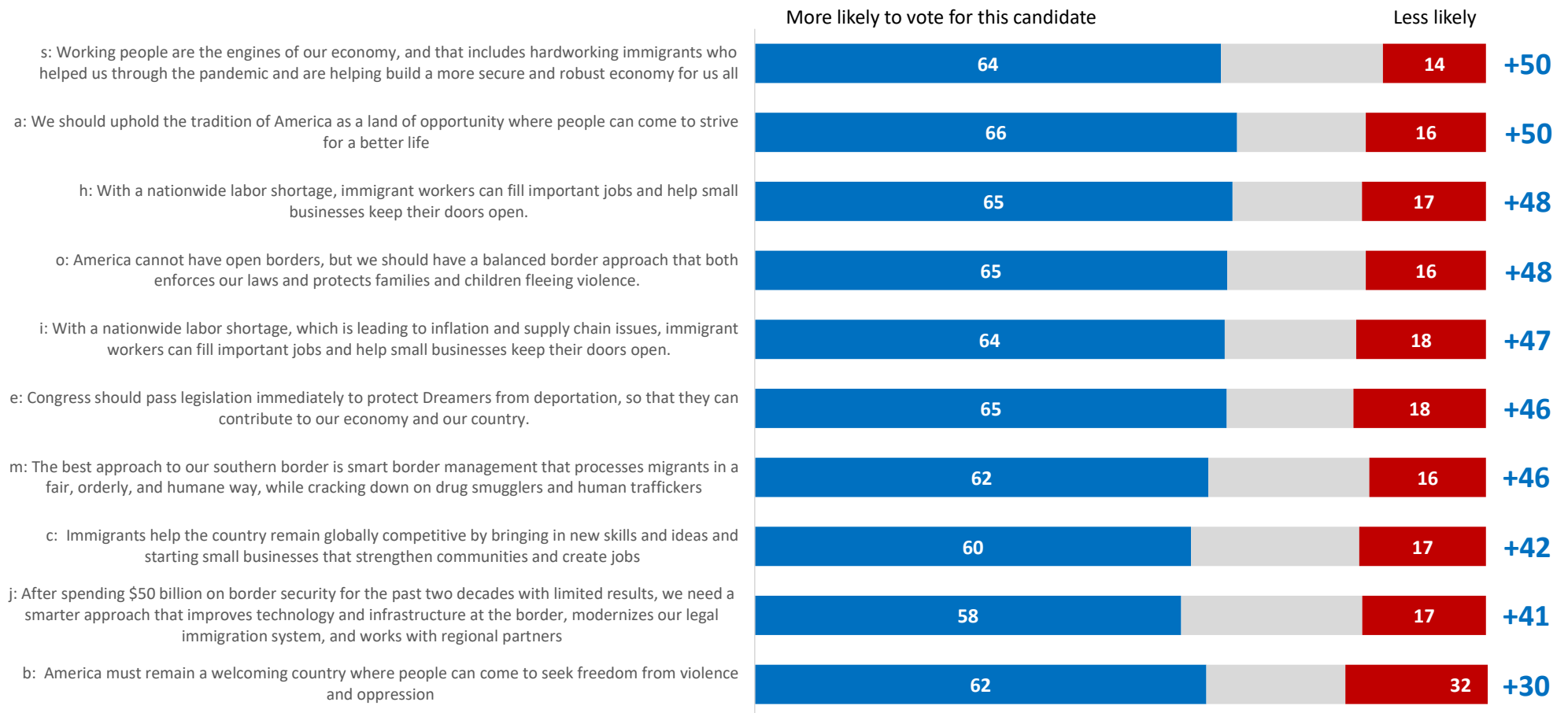
Latino voters: Which candidate do you agree with more

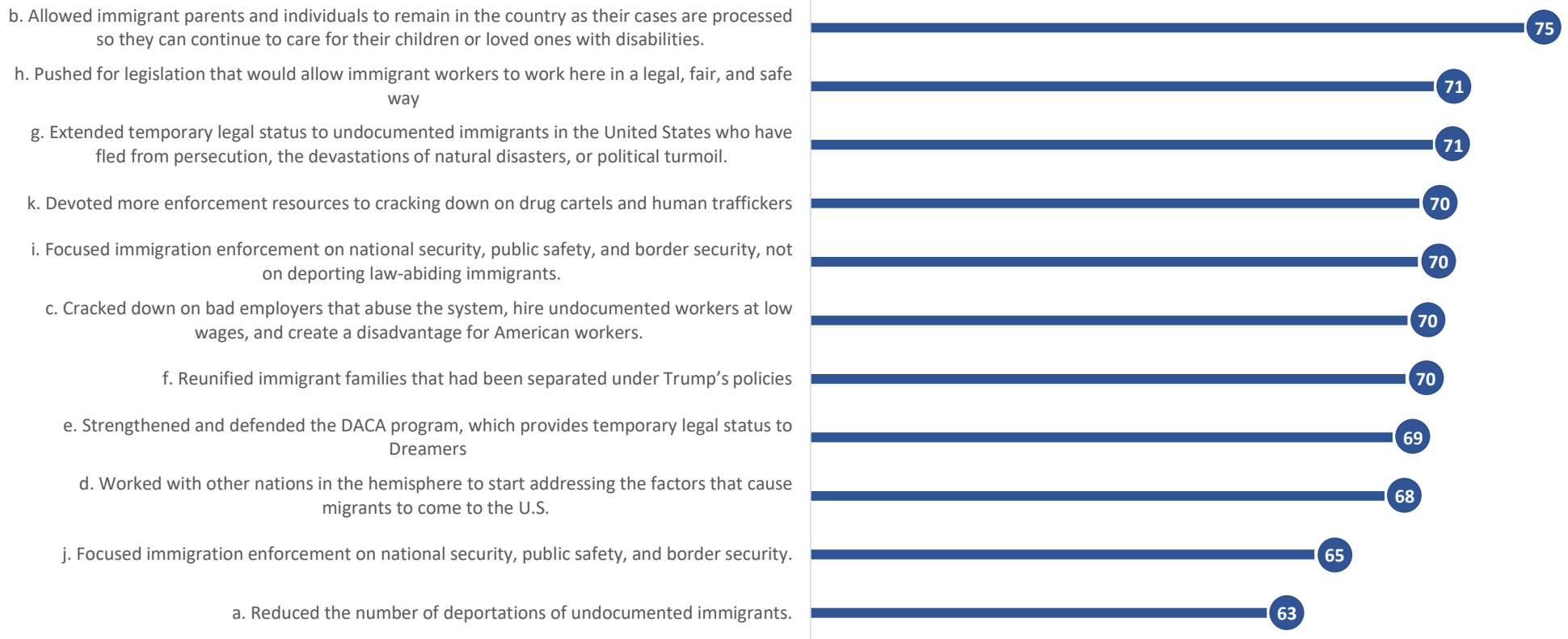

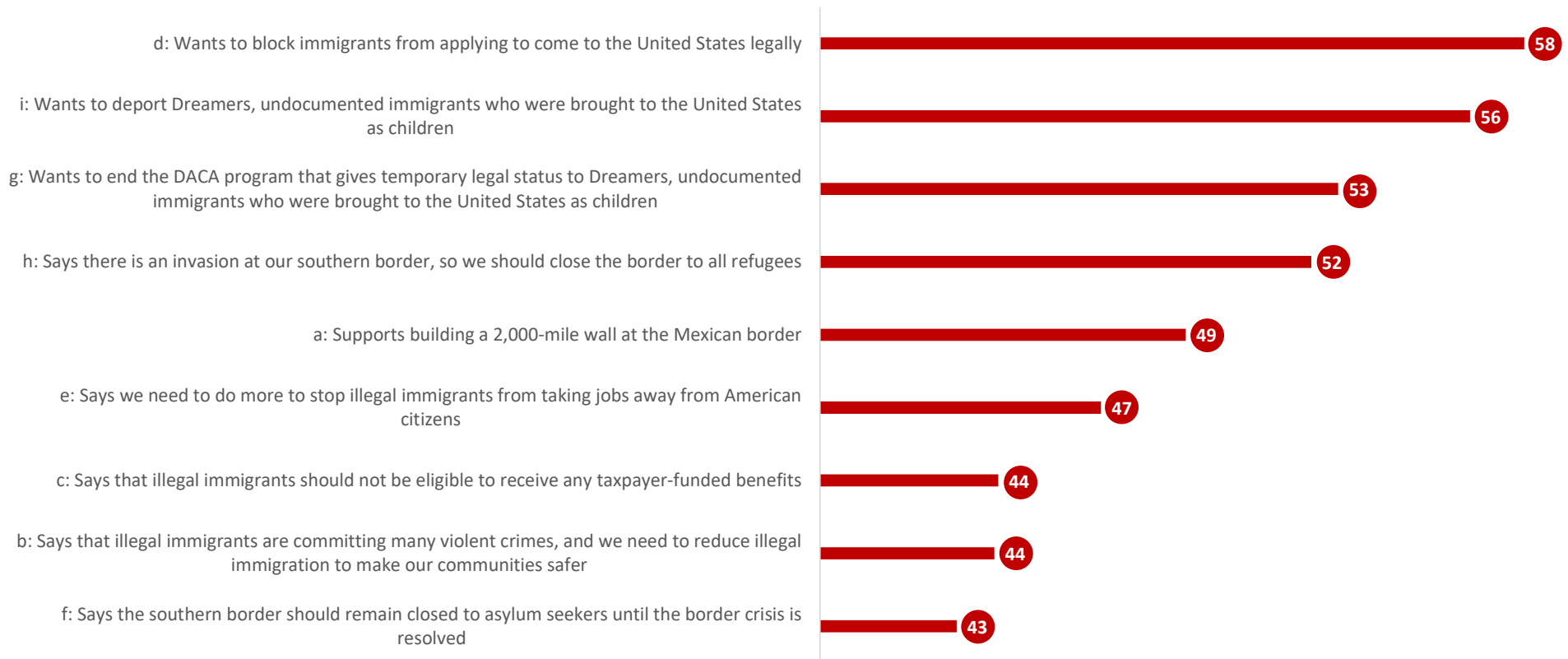
# Strong support for Biden actions on immigration

## Latino voters: Percent favorable on actions taken by Biden administration

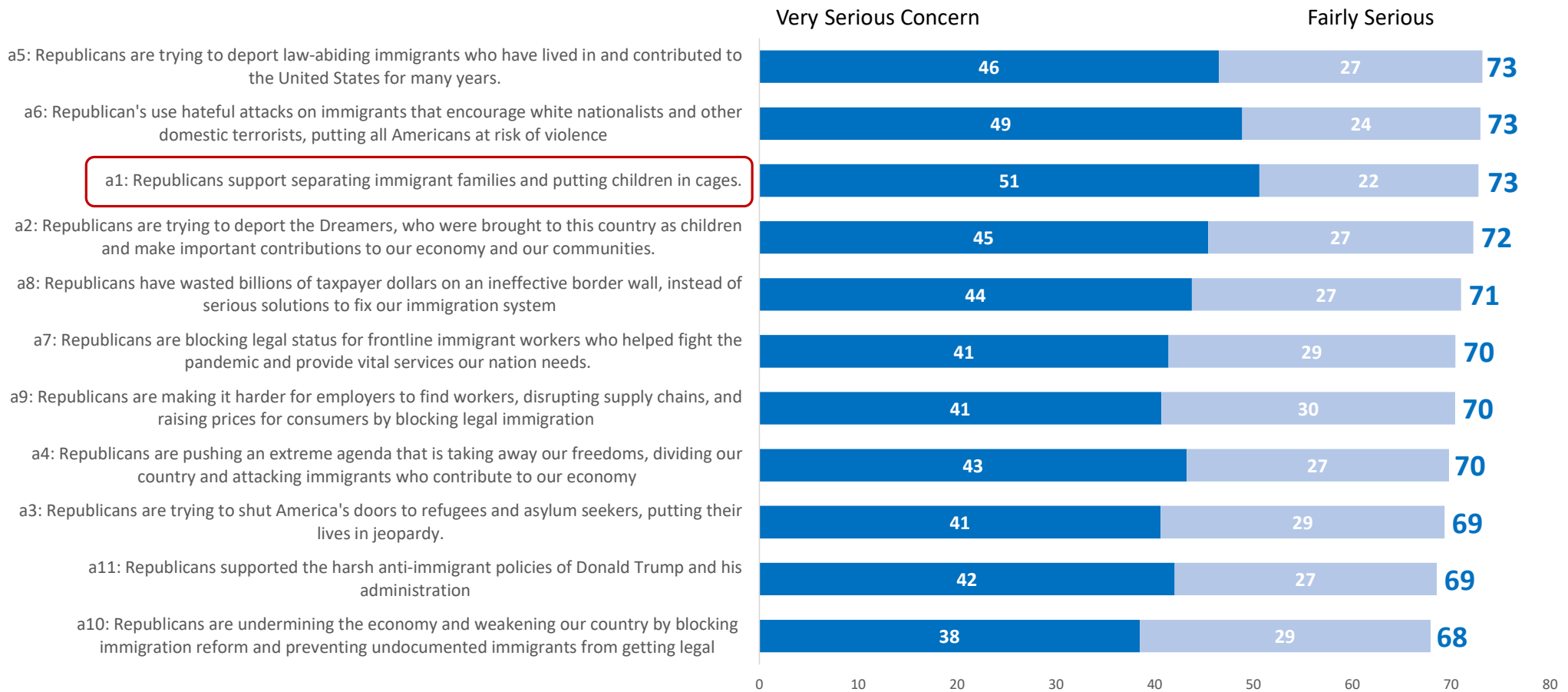


# Opposition to GOP positions on immigration
